Position Overview

We are seeking a versatile, ABC Certified Prosthetist Orthotist who shares our team philosophy, has experience in hand casting and CAD for on-site design and customization, and enjoys working with patients of all ages. The practitioner will demonstrate exceptional design and problem-solving skills for a wide range of prosthetic and orthotic needs, including (but not limited to) upper and lower extremity prosthetics, AFOs, knee bracing, spinal and cervical bracing, CROW walkers, cranial remolding helmets and halo devices for trauma patients. Throughout treatment, the CPO will emphasize patient education and professional collaboration. The ability to communicate with sensitivity and motivate patients to adhere to treatment regimens is essential.

Primary Job Responsibilities

- Evaluate and interview patients to determine their needs
- Take necessary measurements or impressions for fabrication and ordering of devices
- Partner with technicians to design and fabricate devices based on physicians' prescriptions
- Select materials to be used for the orthotic or prosthetic device(s)
- Instruct patients on use and care of their devices
- Adjust, repair, or replace prosthetic and orthotic devices
- Document care in patients' records according to ABC and Medicare standards
- Communicate with physicians, physical and occupational therapists, and other relevant health care providers throughout patients' treatments

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in related field and master's degree or certification in prosthetics and orthotics required
- ABC Certification in good standing
- Four years of experience preferred but not required
- Experience with Futura software preferred
- Experience with HIPPA compliance

Physical Demands

- Ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs., safely support and lift mobile patients, and roll bed-ridden patients as necessary for evaluations, castings, fittings, adjustments, and repairs
