Primary Job Responsibilities

- Assess patients for therapeutic shoes and/or inserts and other orthoses based on physicians' prescriptions
- Use scanning technology, casting, and foam impressions
- Assess and fit basic functional and accommodative foot orthoses
- Assess and fit partial foot prostheses for transmetatarsal or more distal amputations
- Direct technicians and/or assist in fabrication of some items
- Ensure appropriate fit and function of pedorthic devices
- Instruct patients on care of pedorthic devices and confirm their understanding of wear and use of device(s)
- Document medical records per ABC and Medicare standards and complete billing paperwork accurately and efficiently
- Other duties as assigned
